OMAHA, Nebraska – Tuesday, May 15th, Child Saving Institute held a luncheon to celebrate the completion of Phase I of the new building construction. The luncheon honored donors who helped make the new building possible. Guests included Dick Holland whose late wife Mary was a CSI Board Member and visionary for the new facility. In recognition of her commitment to children in the Omaha community and to the children, youth, and families that Child Saving Institute serves, President and CEO Todd Landry announced that upon the project's full completion in 2008, the CSI campus will be dedicated and renamed the "Mary Holland Campus for Children and Youth."
